Local Organizations



House of Neighborly Service

For over 60 years, the House of Neighborly Service (HNS) has provided help and hope to those in our community facing poverty. HNS provides assistance with food, clothing, rent/utilities, transportation and household needs. Comprehensive case management and counseling services help provide long-term solutions to bring people out of crisis and into self-sufficiency.



Habitat for Humanity

Since 1987, Habitat for Humanity has worked to provide safe and affordable housing to low-income individuals and families in our area. Volunteer workers build houses in partnership with prospective homeowners who must personally donate at least 200 hours per adult. Completed houses are sold to recipients with a zero interest mortgage.



Community Kitchen

Established in 1996, Community Kitchen provides food for the hungry, conversation for the lonely, and rest for those struggling. Open seven days a week, Community Kitchen provides either hot meals or sustainable carry-out bags to the homeless, working poor and low-income seniors.

National Organizations



Presbyterian Disaster Assistance

Presbyterian Disaster Assistance (PDA) is the disaster response ministry of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.). It renders aid to communities adversely affected by catastrophic natural events such as tornadoes, hurricanes, floods and fires. Current efforts are directed toward the devastation caused by Hurricanes Helene and Milton on the east coast of the United States. Humanitarian assistance is also being provided to countries in crisis, e.g., Ukraine and Israel.

International Organizations



Marion Medical Mission

Marion Medical Mission (MMM) works in Malawi, Tanzania and Zambia, Africa. MMM, working side by side with indigenous villagers, installs shallow wells in remote areas. A single well provides a sustainable source of clean, safe drinking water for close to 135 men, women and children.



Engalaweni School Breakfast Program

The Engalaweni School Breakfast Program provides a fortified breakfast porridge each school day to 3000 primary school students in Engalaweni and surrounding mission schools. Providing this meal encourages students to attend school, increases self-confidence and classroom participation, improves test scores, and creates a better overall learning environment.
